## **RENEWAL NOTICE - 2017 ENGINEERING LICENSES**

The Council is pleased to remind all engineering offices, contractors and engineers in the Kingdom of Bahrain that offices' and engineers' licenses will expire on 31 December 2016. In accordance with Law no. (51) of 2014 Chapter Four, Licensing Procedures, Article 15 "the license period shall be one year. This period may be renewed upon submitting an application within a period not exceeding thirty days from the date of its expiry.

In case there is a delay in the submission of a renewal application without excuse, to be considered by the Council an additional fee of BD.10 shall be imposed for each day of delay for a maximum of 30 days upon the lapse of such, the license shall be cancelled from the Register and the licensee shall be notified pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Implementing Regulations. Registration of a cancelled license shall not be renewed unless a new license application is submitted which shall be processed and dealt with a new application."

All Engineering offices, contractors and engineers in the Kingdom are required to complete their renewal requirements before 31 December 2016.

The Council wishes to reiterate that 31 December 2016 is the last day to finalize all licensing formalities, as any delays will only affect renewal of licensing for which the Council will not be responsible and penalties will be imposed. The Council seeks your co-operation in ensuring that your license renewals are completed before 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016.
